

Kayaking information for the 2025-26 season

Accommodation

For the 2025-26 kayaking season the crew at Aventurec has created special packages to ensure that our kayaker friends have their needs covered at an attractive price. We offer different accommodation types based on the level of comfort you want to have:

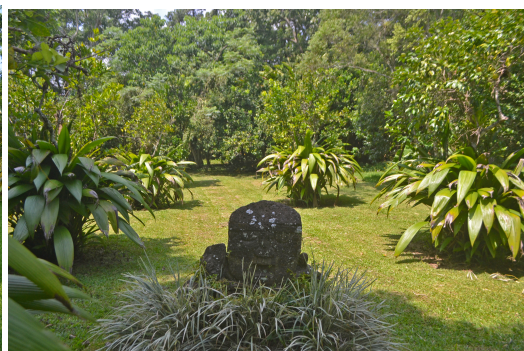
Cabin: From 2 to 10 persons. Each cabin is a private independent building, with an assortment of single and double beds, with a private toilet and shower. It includes bed linens and they get cleaned up every day.



Hostel: Shared rooms with 4 or 5 beds. You will need to share the toilets and showers **and bring your own sleeping gear and towel.**



Camping: Our cheapest option. You are welcome to bring your own sleeping tent and gear to camp in our extensive fields. You would have access to the common toilets and showers.



We have 3 different dining packages to choose from:

Package 1 - Full pension: Our recommended option. It includes accommodation and 2 meals (all you can eat breakfast and dinner buffets) every day so you only have to worry about which river section you want to paddle next!

Package 2 - Half pension: It includes accommodation and breakfast buffet every morning so you get the energy you need to run some drops!

Package 3 - Accommodation only: Our most basic package, it includes only the use of the cabin, hostel or campsite with no dining.

***Half of your stay must be paid on the arrival day.**

***We can take cash USD or MXN, Visa or Masterd Card.**

Outside food or drinks are not allowed into the facilities. We have a fully stocked bar with lots of cold beers and sodas at very affordable prices. **If you don't want the meal packages, we also have a menu so you can order food from the restaurant.**

You are allowed to bring your own cooking kit, such as stove or grill and use it in the delimited areas. However this food cannot be introduced into the restaurant or any of the bedrooms.

Kayak rentals

We have a substantial fleet of kayaks ready to be paddled! If you don't want to fly over your own kayak you can always just come and grab one of ours. We have a wide arrangement of brands, models and sizes just waiting to be taken down the river! Please note that kayak rentals are for the increment of time that you choose at arrival regardless of if you decide to use the equipment.

- **Type 1** kayaks refer to boats that are in good condition with no repairs or cracks.
- **Type 2** kayaks refer to boats that have been broken before and have been repaired. They are still in good conditions to be paddled though.
- **Type 3** kayaks refer to boats that have been broken before and have been repaired several times.

Rental kayaks will **NOT include float bags.**

Note: Kayakers are responsible for bringing **their own set of straps**.

Please note that we require a \$4,000 MXN deposit that is returned to you at the end of the rental period if the boat is in the same condition as it was when leased, that you must pay before you get the boat otherwise you won't be able to take it and also the total amount of the rent. You will be charged for each new crack or other sort of damage on the boat that you are renting.

Shuttles and driver rentals

We understand the importance of having someone driving shuttles when you go to the river, so we offer some options for you when planning a little excursion.

Shuttle Service

Aventurec offers daily shuttle service to all the kayak locations surrounding Tlapacoyan so that you and your boat can get out and tear up the rapids. We ask that all signups and changes be made on the white board at the bar in the Palapa (dining area) the night before or at latest 8:30 AM the morning of. Out of courtesy to all members of the shuttle group, shuttles will leave promptly at 10:00 AM even if someone is missing. Please be timely and already loading your own boat and preparing all your gear before this time!

Shuttle rates go from **\$ 1,660 to \$ 2,860 MXN** (depending on the distance to the river). Cost will be divided into the number of people in the shuttle. (Vehicles are

for up to 7 people with an additional **10% per** person if the vehicle is capable of carrying more). It includes the rental of the van from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm, gasoline and driver.

All shuttles must return to Aventurec by 6:00 PM.

Van and Driver Rental

Aventurec offers the option of renting 7 passenger vans to customers per day or for longer increments of time, including overnight and multi-day trips, both within and out of the region. All vans will be supplied with a driver who will be at the client's disposal during the rental period. Rental fees include the vehicle rental cost and driver salary, it does not include driver's food, and lodging costs. For out of region trips, vehicles will be provided with full tanks of gas and must be returned with full tanks of gas and clients are responsible for all gas cost throughout the trip. A deposit of **\$2,000 MXN** (the cost of a full tank of gas) will be returned to the client(s) upon the return of the vehicle. The cost of renting for **out of region** trips is **MXN 2,300 /day** (ex. Rio Oro, Actopan). If a vehicle is damaged by clients due to misuse during the rental period, clients will be responsible for its repair.

You can bring your own vehicle and hire one of our drivers to do the shuttle for **MXN 560 /day**.

How to get to Aventurec

From Mexico City –Bus to Tlapacoyan. – 6 hours

You can take a Taxi in Benito Juarez Airport (Mexico City) to TAPO bus station. And take a direct bus to Tlapacoyan. ADO. (6 hrs drive) Expect to pay around **\$700 MXN** for these bus tickets. In Tlapacoyan Station, take a Taxi to AVENTUREC (10 min) \$150 pesos.

If you are bringing a kayak. You can still ask for a big taxi from the airport (Mexico City) to the bus station TAPO in Mexico City. (Around \$300 pesos for 2 people and 2 kayaks)

Arriving to Tlapacoyan, A shuttle from Aventurec can pick you up, if you tell us in advance for \$270 pesos. (depending on the hour)

Shuttle from Benito Juarez Airport (Mexico City) direct to Tlapacoyan. (with or with out kayaks). (24hrs)

If you are taking a private shuttle we need your WhatsApp contact and flight information.

If your flight arrives in Mexico City after 5:00 pm. We recommend to take a shuttle to Apan Hidalgo, to hotel "La Hacienda" own by AVENTUREC. Only 1 :30 hrs. shuttle. Spent the night and drive early to Tlapacoyan, so you don't drive very late at night. This shuttle will cost the same as a direct one. And the cost of the hotel will be the same as your pension in AVENTUREC.

From Mexico City Airport – Bus to Puebla- –Bus to Tlapacoyan.

Buses are available directly from the Benito Juarez Airport to Puebla. Make sure to ask to go to Puebla CAPU (there are two bus stations in Puebla), as this is where buses leave from going towards Tlapacoyan. Once in Puebla CAPU, take a bus 3 hours directly to Tlapacoyan, or indirectly through various other bus stations (ex. Teziutlan). Expect to pay around **\$500 MXN** for each bus tickets.

From Puebla – 3 hours

From the Puebla airport, take an airport taxi to the Puebla CAPU bus station. Buses leave every 1 to 2 hours from Puebla CAPU to Tlapacoyan. Same information as above starting from Puebla.

From Veracruz – 5 hours

Buses leave regularly from Veracruz, however these only go as far as Martinez de La Torre. From there, take a 30 min bus ride towards Tlapacoyan and ask driver to stop at Aventurec. Taxi ride is also available from Martinez de La Torre.

If driving from Veracruz, take route 180 north along the coast until Nautla. Take a left onto route 129 west towards Martinez de La Torre and Tlapacoyan. Aventurec is located several kilometers before arriving in Tlapacoyan, and can be identified by the large banner outside the entrance.

From Cancún – 21 hours

We do not recommend making the trip from Cancun to Aventurec in one stretch. There are many rivers and sights to see along the way that you can explore during the daytime, **we strongly advise against traveling during the night.**

Tlapacoyan Station

A taxi service is available directly outside the Tlapacoyan bus station. These will cost around **\$150 MXN** and will take no more than 10 minutes to arrive at Aventurec.

****For your safety, you should always take official taxis from the bus station or the airport if you decide to go with this option****

**** If you rent a car and you are driving in the country, and you get pulled over by the police. If they ask for money,, Say you only have \$500 pesos. And don't give them more.**

Aventurec Kayaker Code of Conduct-Please Read

When in the Palapa

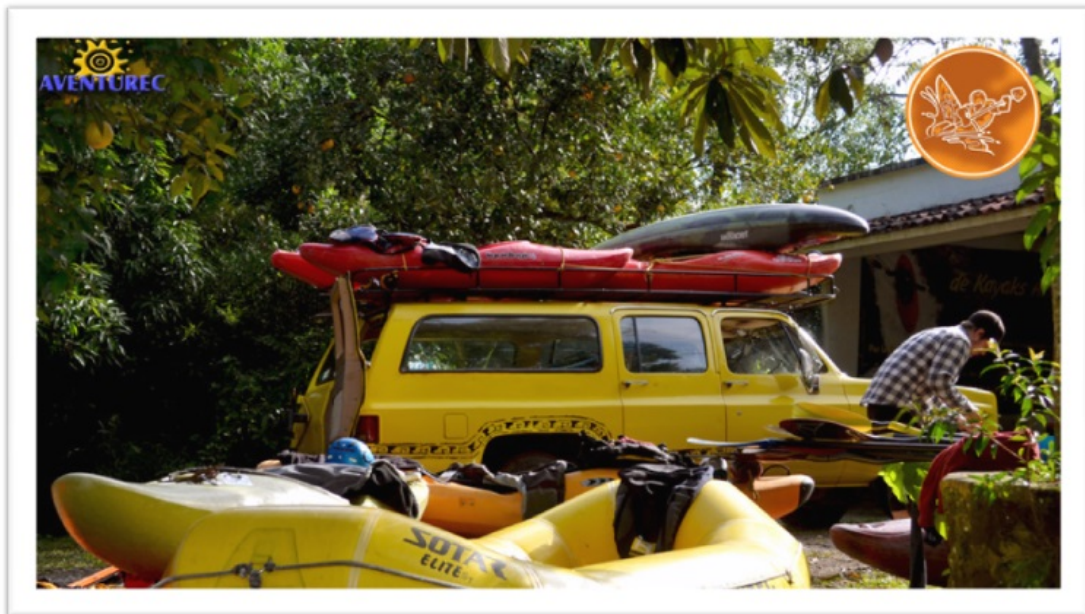
1. Do not smoke under the Palapa.
2. Do not bring any food or beverages into the hostel area or Palapa.
3. Let us know the night in advance if there will be any variations to your meal pension so we can have the correct amount of food made for everyone.
4. Understand that the consumption of drugs anywhere on the premises will not be tolerated.
5. Out of respect to other guests, put an end to any excessively loud gatherings, music or other noises after 10:00 PM.
6. Report any damage to the facilities **AS SOON AS IT HAPPENS**. There will be a charge for any damage to property that was not caused by natural use or wear.
7. Hang all wet items in the designated spaces throughout the facilities.
8. Do not enter the kitchen or other staff only areas.
9. Pay your stay tab weekly to ensure that it doesn't become a red-eyed monster.
10. Serve yourself **ONLY** what you can eat and eat **EVERYTHING** that you serve yourself. We are very fortunate to have plenty of food to eat but many in this world do not. Here at Aventurec, we believe it is unethical to waste food.
11. Know that `Half Pension` meals only include coffee during breakfast but you can still purchase some from the kitchen if you need a pick-me-up cup.

12. Exercise responsibility with your own possessions and gear. Aventurec is a busy place and many kayakers have the same brand of equipment, which can lead to stuff easily being misplaced or stolen.

When in the Bathroom/Hostal/Cabin

1. If lodged in the hostel, please bring your own sheets and pillow.
2. Bring your own towel.
3. ALWAYS dispose of toilet paper in the trash cans next to the toilet.
4. Alert a staff member if toilet paper is needed.
5. Alert a staff member or attend yourself to any toilet malfunctions that were inflicted by you.
6. Alert a staff member if there are any issues with the running hot water.
7. Do not use towels as welcome mats if they are given.
8. Respect our living space as you would respect your living space.

Please note: Aventurec is located in a very humid jungle and the weather is not always warm, sunny Mexico; there are plenty of cold days. Be sure to bring warm clothes for the river AND for the time you are at Aventurec. Also, the mosquitos here are small but they travel in packs, the best way to prevent bug bites is to wear long clothes because bug spray does not always work.
